KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we W.E. Campbell and Emily M. Campbell  
his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of Eight Hundred and Fifty  
DOLLARS,

I have paid by Allen Cook and Mary E. Cook  
the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged and confessed  
do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said Allen Cook and Mary E. Cook  
and unto their heirs and assigns forever, the following lands lying in the City of Tulsa  
Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

Lot seven (7) in Block two (2) in George Perry  
man addition to the City of Tulsa Indian  
Territory according to the recorded plat  
thereof

To have and to hold the same unto the said Allen Cook and Mary E. Cook and unto their  
heirs and assigns forever, with all the appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant... with said Allen Cook and Mary E. Cook that we  
will forever warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Emily M. Campbell wife of the said W.E. Campbell  
for and in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said Allen  
Cook, Mary E. Cook all my rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
