KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That I, Joseph Jacobs, a single man and Indian Territory citizen, for and in consideration of the sum of one dollar and other good and valuable consideration to me paid by J. B. Mc Shea and David P. Thornton DOLLARS, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged,

do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said J. B. Mc Shea and David P. Thornton

and unto their heirs and assigns forever, the following lands lying in the described lot or parcel of ground lying and being situated in the Creek Nation Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

The southwest quarter of the northwest quarter of section one (1) and the south half of the northwest quarter and lots five and six of section two (2), all in Township nineteen (19) North Range fourteen (14) East of the Indian Base and Meridian of the Indian Territory and according to the government survey thereof same being the allotment of Stephen Jacobs my deceased father

To have and to hold the same unto the said J. B. Mc Shea and David P. Thornton and unto their

heirs and assigns forever, with all the appurtenances thereunto belonging.

I, Joseph Jacobs do hereby covenant with said J. B. Mc Shea and David P. Thornton that said lands are free from encumbrances, that I will forever warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

for and in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said
