and unto their heirs and assigns forever, the following lands lying and being
described lot or parcel of ground lying and being
heirs and assigns forever, the following lands lying in the
Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

The fourth-west quarter of Section Fourteen (14) Township
Eighteen (18) North, Range Fourteen (14) East of the
Indian Base and Meridians in Indian
Territory

To have and to hold the same unto the said D. M. Jackson and J. B. McShea, and unto their
heirs and assigns forever, with all the appurtenances thereunto belonging.
Billy Atkins and Salina Atkins,
And hereby covenant with said D. M. Jackson and J. B. McShea that said lands
are free from encumbrances
that they will forever warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And Salina Atkins, wife of the said Billy Atkins,
for and in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said D. M. Jackson and J. B. McShea,
all my rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
