Township 20 range 14 containing 40 acres more or  
less as the case may be according to the Med.  
Survey thereof.

To have and to hold the same unto the said Gray + Adkins Merc. Co. and unto their  
 heirs and assigns forever, with all the appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And <sup>we</sup> hereby covenant with said Gray + Adkins Merc. Co. that we  
 will forever warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Bessie Cordrey wife of the said Eddie Cordrey  
 for and in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said  
 all my rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
