

**WARRANTY DEED** 5756  
WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we *cl. Mamie Sullivan* and *a single woman (enrolled as Mamie Perryman)* of *ifty-five Hundred (\$5500.00)* DOLLARS, for and in consideration of the sum of

to me in hand paid by *W. M. Harner*, receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said *W. M. Harner*

and unto *his* heirs and assigns forever, the following lands lying in the *to reek Nation* Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

*the South East quarter of the North East quarter and lots numbered One (1) and Four (4) all in Section Twenty-five (25), Township Nineteen (19) North, Range Twelve (12) East of the Indian Base and Meridian, in the to reek Nation, Indian Territory, containing One Hundred ten acres more or less*

To have and to hold the same unto the said *W. M. Harner* and unto *his* heirs and assigns forever, with all the appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said *W. M. Harner* that *cl* will forever warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, *cl* wife of the said *W. M. Harner* for and in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said *W. M. Harner* all my rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
