WARRANTY DEED

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WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.
WESTERN JUDICIAL DISTRICT, INDIAN TERRITORY. OFFICIAL FORM

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we J. M. Archer and Elda R. Archer
his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of Eleven Hundred
DOLLARS,

in hand paid by Mary E. Green the receipt of
which is hereby acknowledged and confessed
do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said Mary E. Green
and unto her heirs and assigns forever, the following lands lying in the city of Tulsa
Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

A strip of ground forty (40) feet wide lying on the west side
of the alley extending over lots 5-6-and 7. Six and seven. It is
understood that the north line regardless of the number of the
lot of this strip of land is to the ditch or channel
that runs through the block. All of said property is in
block ninety five (95) Tulsa Indian Territory

To have and to hold the same unto the said Mary E. Green and unto her
heirs and assigns forever, with all the appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said Mary E. Green that we
will forever warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Elda R. Archer wife of the said J. M. Archer
for and in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said Mary
E. Green all my rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
