KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we ch. Rozetta Presley and a seme sole

do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said Mary Barber  
and unto her heirs and assigns forever, the following lands lying in the Creek Nation  
Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

The North one-half (1/2) of the Southeast quarter  
(1/4), and The South west quarter (1/4) of the South-  
east quarter (1/4), section One (1), Township Eighteen  
(18), North, Range Fourteen (14) East. Containing in  
all 120 acres more or less

To have and to hold the same unto the said Mary Barber and unto her  
heirs and assigns forever, with all the appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said Mary Barber that ch  
will forever warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, / wife of the said /  
for and in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said /  
all my rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
