KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we Thomas Hickory and Jennie Hickory
his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of Three thousand (\$3000.00)
DOLLARS, to us in hand paid by Ethel Davis the
receipt of which is hereby acknowledged

do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said Ethel Davis
and unto her heirs and assigns forever, the following lands lying in the Creek Nation
Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

The South East Quarter of the South West Quarter of Section Seven (7)
The South West Quarter of the South East Quarter of Section Seven (7)
And The North East Quarter of the South West Quarter of Section Eight (8)
All in Township Seventeen (17) North and Range Fourteen (14) East, the
same being the surplus allotment of the said Thomas Hickory
the Grantor herein and containing One hundred and twenty five
more or less

To have and to hold the same unto the said Ethel Davis and unto her
heirs and assigns forever, with all the appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said Ethel Davis that they
will forever warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Jennie Hickory nee Honey wife of the said Thomas Hickory
for and in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said Ethel
Davis her heirs and assigns forever all my rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
