

WARRANTY DEED 5812
 WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.
 WESTERN JUDICIAL DISTRICT, INDIAN TERRITORY. OFFICIAL FORM

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we David Holbrook and Laura Holbrook
 his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred fifty five
 DOLLARS, in hand paid, the receipt of which is
hereby acknowledged

do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said Harriet W. Morris
 and unto her heirs and assigns forever, the following lands lying in the Creek Nation
 Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

Lot 67 five, Block 67 five in the Bellview
addition to the town of Tulsa, Indian
Territory

To have and to hold the same unto the said Harriet W. Morris and unto her
 heirs and assigns forever, with all the appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said Harriet W. Morris that she
will forever warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatsoever.

And I, Laura Holbrook wife of the said David Holbrook

for and in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said Harriet
W. Morris all my rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
