do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said William M. Jewel
and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following lands lying in the Sebek Nation
Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

all of the S 1/2 of the NE 1/4 + the N 1/4 of the N.E 1/4 all
in Sec. 22; + all of the S 1/2 of the S.E. 1/4 + the N 1/4
of the S.E. 1/4, all in Sec. 21, + both pieces in Twp. 19 N,
Rang. 13. E. being the allotment of my mother +
Sister both Deceased

To have and to hold the same unto the said William M. Jewel and unto his
heirs and assigns forever, with all the appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said William M. Jewel that el
will forever warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.
