South one-half 1/2 of the South West one fourth 1/4 of Section Fifteen (15)  
Township eighteen (18) Range Thirteen (13) East. North one-half (1/2) of the  
North West Quarter (1/4) of Section fourteen (14) Township Nineteen (19) North
