

WARRANTY DEED
WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.
WESTERN JUDICIAL DISTRICT, INDIAN TERRITORY. OFFICIAL FORM

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KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we Wattie Grayson and "Single Person" and
Heir at Law of Sunday Grayson Deceased for and in consideration of the sum of Four Hundred + no/100
DOLLARS, to me in hand by E. A. Naughey the receipt
of which is hereby acknowledged

do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said E. A. Naughey
and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following lands lying in the Leitch Nation
Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit: All my undivided one fourth (1/4)
interest in and to the North East Quarter of the South
East Quarter of Section Four (4) and the North Half of the
North East Quarter of Section Fifteen (15) All in Town-
ship Nineteen (19) North Range Fourteen (14) East, Con-
taining 12.0 Acres more or less and being the Surplus
Allotment of Sunday Grayson "Deceased"

To have and to hold the same unto the said E. A. Naughey and unto his
heirs and assigns forever, with all the appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said E. A. Naughey that cl
will forever warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Wattie Grayson wife of the said Wattie Grayson
for and in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said
all my rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
