 WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.
 WESTERN JUDICIAL DISTRICT, INDIAN TERRITORY. OFFICIAL FORM

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That *Wattie Grayson* ~~and~~ *single* ~~unmarried~~
 his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of *Three Thousand*
 DOLLARS, to me hand paid by *Samuel B. Davis* the
 receipt of which is hereby acknowledged

do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said *Samuel B. Davis*
 and unto *his* heirs and assigns forever, the following lands lying in the *Sevier Nation*
 Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

*The North half of the South East Quarter of Section Seven and the
 North East Quarter of the South West Quarter of Section Seven,
 all in Township Sixteen North Range Fourteen East
 containing 120 acres more or less and being the surplus
 allotment of the said Wattie Grayson the Grantor
 herein*

To have and to hold the same unto the said *Samuel B. Davis* and unto *his*
 heirs and assigns forever, with all the appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said *Samuel B. Davis* that *he*
 will forever warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, *Wattie Grayson* wife of the said *Samuel B. Davis*
 for and in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said
 all my rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
