KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of *Four Hundred + 00*
DOLLARS, *to me in hand paid by E. A. Naughey, the*
receipt of which is hereby acknowledged

do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said *E. A. Naughey*
and unto *his* heirs and assigns forever, the following lands lying in the *Leeds Nation*
Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit: *all my undivided one-fourth interest*
in and to the North half of the North East Quarter of section
Fifteen (15) and the North East Quarter of the South East
Quarter of section Four (4) Township Nineteen (19) North
Range Thirteen (13) East consisting of 120 acres more
or less and being the surplus allotment of Sunday
Grayson Deceased

To have and to hold the same unto the said *E. A. Naughey* and unto *his*
heirs and assigns forever, with all the appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said *E. A. Naughey* that *he*
will forever warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, *Wattie Grayson* wife of the said *E. A. Naughey*
for and in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said *E. A. Naughey*
all my rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
