WARRANTY DEED WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS.

That we Susie Sugar nee Grayson and Janie Grayson heirs at law of Sunday Grayson deceased for and in consideration of the sum of One Dollar each hands paid by DOLLARS, Ethel Davis the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged

do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto said Ethel Davis and unto her heirs and assigns forever, the following lands lying in the Creek Nation Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

all our undivided interests and title in and to the north-east quarter of the south-east quarter of Section four (4) and the north-half of the north-east quarter of Section Fifteen (15) all in township nineteen (19), north Range (13) east, the same being the surplus allotment of Sunday Grayson deceased, and containing one hundred and twenty acres more or less
TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same unto the said Ethel Davis and unto her heirs

and assigns forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said Ethel Davis that we will forever warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Ethel Davis, wife of the said Janie Grayson for and in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said Janie Grayson all right of dower and homestead in and to said lands.
