bargain, sell and convey unto said Mrs L. E. Earns and unto her heirs and assigns forever, the followinglands lying in the Creek nation Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:
All of Lot eight in Block One (L & Blk 1) in Earns
Additions to Tulsa Indian Territory according
to the Plat filed in the Records & Deeds at Tulsa, Ok.TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same unto the said Mrs L. E. Earns and unto her heirs
and assigns forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.And hereby covenant with said Mrs L. E. Earns that we will forever warrant and de-
fend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.And I, Mrs Myrtle A. Earns wife of the said H. A. Earns for and in consideration of the said sum of
