WARRANTY DEED
WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS.

That we M. Forelett Smith and Sadie Smith
his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of nine hundred DOLLARS,
in hand paid by Stephen B Smith the receipt of
which is hereby acknowledged do hereby grant,
bargain, sell and convey unto said Stephen B Smith and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following
lands lying in the Creek Nation Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

all of Lots nos seven and eight (7 and 8) in
Block no eleven 41 in the Burnett Addition
to the City of Tulsa Indian Territory accord-
ing to the amended plat of said addition

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same unto the said Stephen B Smith and unto his heirs
and assigns forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said Stephen B Smith that we will forever warrant and de-
fend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Sadie Smith wife of the said M. Forelett Smith for and in consideration of the said sum of
money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said Stephen B Smith all right of dower and homestead in and to said lands.
