**WARRANTY DEED
WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.**

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS.

That we Charles W. Grimes and Josephine Grimes
his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of five DOLLARS,
in hand paid by Jennie A. Brink the
receipt of which is hereby acknowledged do hereby grant,
bargain, sell and convey unto said Jennie A. Brink and unto her heirs and assigns forever, the following
lands lying in the Creek Nation Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

Lot no 6 in Block no 5 in Bellview
addition to Tulsa known as Tulsa Heights

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same unto the said Jennie A. Brink and unto her heirs
and assigns forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant S with said Jennie A. Brink that he will forever warrant and de-
fend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Josephine Grimes wife of the said Charles W. Grimes for and in consideration of the said sum of
money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said Jennie A. Brink all right of dower and homestead in and to said lands.
