WARRANTY DEED WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS.

That we E. B. Lynch and Jay Forsythe and E. J. Lynch and Jennie Forsythe
 their wives, for and in consideration of the sum of Four hundred and 40/100 DOLLARS,
 The receipt of which is hereby acknowledged in full

do hereby grant,
 bargain, sell and convey unto said Mattie E. Miller and unto her heirs and assigns forever, the following
 lands lying in the Creek nation Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

Lot Five (5) Block fifteen (15) Lynch and Forsythe's
Addition to Triltsch's Tr

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same unto the said Mattie E. Miller and unto her heirs
 and assigns forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said Mattie E. Miller that they will forever warrant and de-
 fend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, me E. J. Lynch, wife of the said E. B. Lynch and Jay Forsythe for and in consideration of the said sum of
 money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said Mattie E. Miller all right of dower and homestead in and to said lands.
