WARRANTY DEED  
WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS.

That we Chesley Starr and  
his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of Two Hundred DOLLARS,  
the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged from  
Lilah D. Lindsey, and her husband, W. Lindsey do hereby grant,  
bargain, sell and convey unto said Lilah D. Lindsey and unto their heirs and assigns forever, the following  
lands lying in the Creek Nation Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

The south twenty acres of the N W 1/4 of the NW 1/4  
of Sec 4 TP 9, R 4, E

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same unto the said Lilah D. Lindsey and her husband W. Lindsey and unto their heirs  
and assigns forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said Lilah D. Lindsey and W. Lindsey that he will forever warrant and de-  
fend the title of said lands against all claims whatever. to the said grantee

And I, Chesley Starr, wife of the said single man for and in consideration of the said sum of  
money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said Lilah D. Lindsey and her husband W. Lindsey all right of dower and homestead in and to said lands.
