

WARRANTY DEED WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS.

receipt of which is hereby acknowledged. do hereby grant,

bargain, sell and convey unto said *Clara A Latham* ^{the} and unto *her* ^{my wife} heirs and assigns forever, the following

lands lying in the Creek Nation Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit: situated in the Co-

of Tulsa and thus more particularly described as follows: Beginning at the N.W. corner of lot one, about one hundred feet from the railroad, I lay off a plat of Tulsa Co. ground, right angle, south Third St. in a southerly direction along the alley line 100 feet; thence to right angle in westerly direction 25 feet; thence at right angles in northerly direction 100 feet to third st.; thence at right angles in a southerly direction 25 feet to place of beginning; the same bearing & distance 119 ft by 100 feet deep - forming a part of lots One (1) and Two (2), and said lots 119 ft by 100 feet deep, all that part of lots Two (2) which is herein conveyed which shall hereinafter be open for an alley or to be used as a driveway for the purpose of the same being adjacent to a certain lot owned by J. H. Gage, et al Oct 5, 1905 for 500 sq ft of the original north & company of Okla. No. 27.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same unto the said Blara a Latham and unto her heirs and assigns forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenants with said Clara A Latham that I will forever warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever, except a certain mortgage dated Oct 5-1905 for \$2500 in favor of the Shortell Mortgage Company of New York Inc, which grantee agrees to assume and pay
