OFFICIAL FORMWARRANTY DEED  
WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS.

That we Katie L. Wallace and George H. Wallace  
his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of Fourteen Hundred and Fifty <sup>two</sup> DOLLARS,  
in hand paid by Henry P. Lukens the receipt of  
which is hereby acknowledged do hereby grant,  
bargain, sell and convey unto said Henry P. Lukens and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following  
lands lying in the Creek Nation Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

The west half of the south east quarter and the  
southeast quarter of the southeast quarter of  
section ten (10) township nineteen (19) Range  
fourteen (14) east of the Indian Meridian and  
being a part of the allotment of Jossas Love

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same unto the said Henry P. Lukens and unto his heirs  
and assigns forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said Henry P. Lukens that They will forever warrant and de-  
fend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, George H. Wallace husband of the said Katie L. Wallace for and in consideration of the said sum of  
money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said Henry P. Lukens all right of dower and homestead in and to said lands.
