WARRANTY DEED WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER,

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS.

That we Mary Emarthla nee Fuswa and Emarthla
her husband, for and in consideration of the sum of One Thousand (\$1000.00) DOLLARS,
to Mary Emarthla paid cash in hand receipt of which
is hereby acknowledged to have been paid by William M. Feivel do hereby grant,
bargain, sell and convey unto said William M. Feivel and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following
lands lying in the Western Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:
all of the north half of the E 1/4 of the SE 1/4 of the
NW 1/4 of the NW 1/4 of the SE 1/4 of Section two (2) Twp
19 N Range 11 East containing 16 acres more
or less in the Creek Nation IT the same being
the allotment of my deceased father Tuo Thlocos I am
his only child and heir
TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same unto the said William M. Feivel and unto his heirs
and assigns forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said William M. Feivel that we will forever warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Emarthla, wife of the said Mary Emarthla for and in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said William M. Feivel all right of dower and homestead in and to said lands.
