WARRANTY DEED WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS.

That we E. B. Harrington and Bertha Harrington
his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of Four Hundred Twenty-five (\$425.00) DOLLARS,
to us in hand paid by O. R. Clark, the receipt of which is
hereby acknowledged and confessed, do hereby grant,
bargain, sell and convey unto said O. R. Clark and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following
lands lying in the City of Tulsa Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:
All of Lot Number Six (6) in Block Number Four (4) in
Slavbery Addition to Tulsa in accordance with the re-
corded plat thereof.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same unto the said O. R. Clark and unto his heirs
and assigns forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said O. R. Clark that they will forever warrant and de-
fend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Bertha Harrington, wife of the said E. B. Harrington, for and in consideration of the said sum of
money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said O. R. Clark all right of dower and homestead in and to said lands.
