OFFICIAL FORMWARRANTY DEED
WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS.

That we Sammie Naharkey the surviving heir of more Naharkey deceased and being a single and unmarried person his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of Fifty and no/100 DOLLARS, to me in hand paid by W.P. Moore the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do hereby grant,

bargain, sell and convey unto said W.P. Moore and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following lands lying in the Creek Nation Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

all my undivided right title and interest in and to the more or less quarter of the said west quarter of Section Twelve (12) Township nineteen (19) north and Range twelve (12) east the same being the homestead allotment of William Naharkey deceased and containing forty acres more or less according to U.S. Government survey thereof
TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same unto the said W.P. Moore and unto his heirs and assigns forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant S. with said W.P. Moore that I will forever warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Sammie Naharkey, wife of the said W.P. Moore for and in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said W.P. Moore all right of dower and homestead in and to said lands.
