WARRANTY DEED WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS,

That we Elizabeth M. Graham, a single and unmarried woman,
his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of Two hundred, no \$100 DOLLARS,

do hereby grant,
bargain, sell and convey unto said the C. C. Turk and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following
lands lying in the Cherokee Nation Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

beginning at the southeast corner of the northwest quarter of
the southeast quarter of Section twenty (20), Township twenty-two (22) North, Range
fourteen (14) East, strip of land enclosed by the fence as follows - beginning at the
above described point thence running West one hundred eighty three (183) feet
thence North four hundred fifteen and one half (416 1/2) feet thence running East
one hundred eighty three (183) feet thence North four hundred fifteen and
one half (416 1/2) feet to place of beginning.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same unto the said C. C. Turk and unto his heirs
and assigns forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said C. C. Turk that I will forever warrant and de-
fend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Elizabeth M. Graham (wife of the said C. C. Turk) for and in consideration of the said sum of
money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said C. C. Turk all right of dower and homestead in and to said lands.
