OFFICIAL FORMWARRANTY DEED
WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS.

That we N. E. Campbell and Emily M. Campbell
his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of Eleven Hundred Twenty eight DOLLARS,
to them in hand paid by W. M. McAllister, the receipt whereof
is hereby conferred and acknowledged, do hereby grant,
bargain, sell and convey unto said W. M. McAllister and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following
lands lying in the Town of Tulsa, Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

Lots numbered Five and six in Block numbered Three of
the George Perryman Addition to Tulsa, I. T. according to the
recorded plat thereof.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same unto the said W. M. McAllister and unto his heirs
and assigns forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said W. M. McAllister that they will forever warrant and de-
fend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Emily M. Campbell, wife of the said N. E. Campbell for and in consideration of the said sum of
money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said W. M. McAllister all right of dower and homestead in and to said lands.
