TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same unto the said W. O. Dickinson and unto his heirs  
 and assigns forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said W. O. Dickinson that she will forever warrant and de-  
 fend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Callie Grayson, wife of the said W. O. Dickinson for and in consideration of the said sum of  
 money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said W. O. Dickinson all right of dower and homestead in and to said lands.
