KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS.

That we W. L. Britton and Susie L. Britton  
his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of One Thousand and no DOLLARS,  
the same being here by acknowledged and to us in hand  
paid do hereby grant,  
bargain, sell and convey unto said R. C. Strickland and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following  
lands lying in the City of Tulsa Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:  
South Fifth Street Lot Two (2) Block Three (3) in the  
"Burnette Addition" to the City of Tulsa, Indian Terr., and  
according to the plat hereof.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same unto the said R. C. Strickland and unto his heirs  
and assigns forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said R. C. Strickland that they will forever warrant and de-  
fend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Susie L. Britton, wife of the said W. L. Britton for and in consideration of the said sum of  
money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said R. C. Strickland all right of dower and homestead in and to said lands.
