the receipt of the same being hereby acknowledged and  
to be paid by Nora Marshall do hereby grant,  
bargain, sell and convey unto said Nora Marshall and unto her heirs and assigns forever, the following  
lands lying in the City of Tulsa Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

sect 30 Lot 3; and all Lot 4 both in Block 9;  
and according to the official plat of Government survey  
of said City of Tulsa Indian

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same unto the said Nora Marshall and unto her heirs  
and assigns forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said Nora Marshall that she will forever warrant and de-  
fend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, O. P. Marshall, wife of the said O. P. Marshall for and in consideration of the said sum of  
~~money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said~~ Nora Marshall ~~all right of dower and homestead in and to said lands.~~
