of which is hereby acknowledged do hereby grant,
bargain, sell and convey unto said Frank S. Foster and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following
lands lying in the Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

Lot three (3) in Block three (3) in the
Belleview Addition to Tulsa

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same unto the said Frank S. Foster and unto his heirs
and assigns forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said Frank S. Foster that I will forever warrant and de-
fend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, my, wife of the said Frank S. Foster for and in consideration of the said sum of
money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said Frank S. Foster all right of dower and homestead in and to said lands.
