WARRANTY DEED WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS.

That we F. J. Rodolf, a single man and his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of Twelve Hundred Fifty (\$1250.00) DOLLARS, to him in hand paid by Mary E. Kennedy, the receipt whereof is hereby confessed and acknowledged, do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto said Mary E. Kennedy and unto her heirs and assigns forever, the following lands lying in the Town of Ilesa Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit: Lot numbered Two in Block Numbered Five in the Tract and Gillette Addition to Ilesa, Indian Territory, according to the Government plat thereof.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same unto the said Mary E. Kennedy and unto her heirs and assigns forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant s. with said Mary E. Kennedy that he will forever warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, wife of the said for and in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said all right of dower and homestead in and to said lands.
