# WARRANTY DEED WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS,

That we Henry Hornecker and Belle Hornecker  
his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of Four Thousand (\$4000.00) DOLLARS,

do hereby grant,  
bargain, sell and convey unto said J. A. Friend and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following  
lands lying in the City of Tulsa, I. T. Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

West twenty-five (25) feet of lots one (1) and two (2) uniform width  
block seventy-four (74), and all improvements thereon, and situated  
in the City of Tulsa, I. T.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same unto the said J. A. Friend and unto his heirs and assigns forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said J. A. Friend that they will forever warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Belle Hornecker, wife of the said Henry Hornecker for and in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said J. A. Friend all right of dower and homestead in and to said lands.
