OFFICIAL FORMWARRANTY DEED
WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS.

That we Chisso Childers and Millie Childers
his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of Three Hundred & Forty no DOLLARS,
the receipt of the same being hereby acknow
ledged and to us paid by C. E. Beyle do hereby grant,
bargain, sell and convey unto said C. E. Beyle and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following

lands lying in the Creek Nation Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

Beginning at the north east corner of the
allotment of Chisso Childers located in the
N. W. 1/4 of Sec. 3 Twp. 19 N. Rge. 12 E.; thence running
west 191 feet; thence south 560 feet; thence east 191
feet thence north 560 feet to the place of beginning
and containing 3.25 acres more or less, this being a part of the
land to be sold by the Creek Nation to the U. S. Government
TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same unto the said C. E. Beyle and unto his heirs
and assigns forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said C. E. Beyle that they will forever warrant and de-
fend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Millie Childers, wife of the said Chisso Childers for and in consideration of the said sum of
money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said C. E. Beyle all right of dower and homestead in and to said lands.
