OFFICIAL FORMWARRANTY DEED
WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS.

That we Jonathon Carr and Rosie E. Carr
his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of Seven Hundred fifty and No/100 (6750.00) DOLLARS,
to them paid cash in hand, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged from
Frank Linker, of Skiatook, I.T.
do hereby grant,
bargain, sell and convey unto said Frank Linker and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following

lands lying in the Cherokee Nation Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:
All and entirely of lot number Seventeen (17) in block number
nine (9) in the town of Skiatook, Indian Territory, according
to the original survey and recorded plat thereof

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same unto the said Frank Linker and unto his heirs
and assigns forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said Frank Linker that they will forever warrant and de-
fend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Rosie E. Carr, wife of the said Jonathon Carr for and in consideration of the said sum of
money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said Frank Linker all right of dower and homestead in and to said lands.
