which is hereby acknowledged do hereby grant,  
bargain, sell and convey unto said Mari Aschleman and unto her heirs and assigns forever, the following  
lands lying in the city of Tulsa Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:  
Block Number Sixty three (63)

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same unto the said Mari Aschleman and unto her heirs  
and assigns forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said Mari Aschleman that we will forever warrant and de-  
fend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Elta Bartter, wife of the said E. O. Bartter for and in consideration of the said sum of  
money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said Mari Aschleman all right of dower and homestead in and to said lands.
