KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS.

That we J. M. Gillette and Minnie M. Gillette, his wife, and J. M. Hall and Jennie S. Hall, his wife, and J. M. Harker and Carrie S. Harker, his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of Six hundred (\$600.00) DOLLARS, to us in hand paid by John Mc Nicol, receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged.

do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto said John Mc Nicol and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following lands lying in the brick section Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

Lot Twenty five (25) and Twenty six (26) in Block Nine (9) in the Gillette Hall Addition to the City of Tulsa, Indian Territory according to the Recorded plat thereof.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same unto the said John Mc Nicol and unto his heirs and assigns forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said John Mc Nicol that will forever warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.
