WARRANTY DEED WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS.

That we George F. Blevins and Maud Blevins
his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of One, \$100 DOLLARS,

do hereby grant,
bargain, sell and convey unto said William J. Little and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following
lands lying in the Cherokee Nation Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

all of Lot number six (6) in Block number eighty-nine (89)
in the town of Ballinsville, Indian Territory, as per the United
States Government survey and plat of said town.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same unto the said William J. Little and unto his heirs
and assigns forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said William J. Little that we will forever warrant and de-
fend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Maud Blevins, wife of the said George F. Blevins for and in consideration of the said sum of
money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said William J. Little all right of dower and homestead in and to said lands.
