OFFICIAL FORMWARRANTY DEED
WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS.

That we R. E. Lynch and G. L. Lynch
his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of One Thousand ~~no~~ DOLLARS,
the receipt of the same being hereby acknowledged
& was paid by J. M. Hall do hereby grant,
bargain, sell and convey unto said J. M. Hall and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following
lands lying in the Cherokee Nation Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

The north-east quarter of the south-east quarter,
and the north-west-quarter of the south-east
quarter of the south-east quarter of Section fifteen
(15) Township Twenty (20) N Range Thirtent (3) east
Cherokee Nation I.T.,

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same unto the said J. M. Hall and unto his heirs
and assigns forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said J. M. Hall that they will forever warrant and de-
fend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, G. L. Lynch, wife of the said R. E. Lynch for and in consideration of the said sum of
money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said J. M. Hall all right of dower and homestead in and to said lands.
