WARRANTY DEED WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS.

That we A. F. Antle and Leona Antle
his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of Eleven Thousand (\$11,000.00) DOLLARS,
to them in hand paid by J. D. Hagler, the receipt whereof
is hereby confessed and acknowledged, do hereby grant,
bargain, sell and convey unto said J. D. Hagler and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following
lands lying in the Town of Tulsa Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:
an undivided one half interest in and to Lot numbered Eleven
in Block numbered Seventy Three in the City of Tulsa, ac-
cording to the Government Plat thereof.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same unto the said J. D. Hagler and unto his heirs
and assigns forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said J. D. Hagler that they will forever warrant and de-
fend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Leona Antle, wife of the said A. F. Antle for and in consideration of the said sum of
money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said J. D. Hagler all right of dower and homestead in and to said lands.
