WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS.

That we C. M. Hooper and M. E. Hooper
his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of Eight Hundred DOLLARS,
in hand paid by George B. Blackburn,
do hereby grant,
bargain, sell and convey unto said George B. Blackburn and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following
lands lying in the City of Tulsa Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:
Lot one (1) Block one hundred and ninety eight (198) in the
Town of Tulsa, Indian Territory, according to the official survey.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same unto the said George B. Blackburn and unto his heirs
and assigns forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said George B. Blackburn that I will forever warrant and de-
fend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, M. E. Hooper, wife of the said C. M. Hooper for and in consideration of the said sum of
money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said George B. Blackburn all right of dower and homestead in and to said lands.
