WARRANTY DEED WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS.

That we W P Moore and Anna E Moore
his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of One (\$1.00) DOLLARS,
and other valuable considerations the receipt of which
is hereby acknowledged and confessed, do hereby grant,
bargain, sell and convey unto M B Shutt and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following
lands lying in the Creek Nation Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

The south-east quarter 1/4 of section nineteen
19 Township nineteen (9) north Range fourteen (4)
east

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same unto the said M B Shutt and unto his heirs
and assigns forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said M B Shutt that we will forever warrant and de-
fend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Anna E Moore wife of the said W P Moore for and in consideration of the said sum of
money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said M B Shutt all right of dower and homestead in and to said lands.
