OFFICIAL FORMWARRANTY DEED  
WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS.

That we H. J. Gallini and Frank Gallini  
his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of seventeen hundred and thirty-two DOLLARS,  
in hand paid by Loren Conaway receipt of which is hereby acknow-  
ledged and confessed do hereby grant,  
bargain, sell and convey unto said Loren Conaway and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following  
lands lying in the city of Tulsa Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

Lot Four (4) in Block Three (3) in the Friend & Gillette addition  
to the city of Tulsa Indian Territory according to and as shown  
by the recorded plat of the said addition

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same unto the said Loren Conaway and unto his heirs  
and assigns forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said Loren Conaway that we will forever warrant and de-  
fend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Frances Gallini, wife of the said H. J. Gallini for and in consideration of the said sum of  
money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said Loren Conaway all right of dower and homestead in and to said lands.
