OFFICIAL FORMWARRANTY DEED
WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS,

That we *J. M. Gillette and Minnie* and *J. M. Gillette his wife, J. M. Hall and Carrie L. Hocker* do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto said *Annice Wilder* and unto her heirs and assigns forever, the following lands lying in the *Creek Nation Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:*

Lots One (1) and Two (2) in Block twenty (20) and Lots Six (6) and seven (7) in Block three (3) in the Gillette-Hall addition to the City of Tulsa Indian Territory

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same unto the said *Annice Wilder* and unto her heirs and assigns forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant s. with said *Annice Wilder* that *we* will forever warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever. *except as set out and set out here by Grant to Stephens or his assigns*

And I, *Minnie M. Gillette* wife of the said *J. M. Gillette* for and in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said *Annice Wilder* all right of dower and homestead in and to said lands.
