KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS.

That we Henry Hornecker and Belle Hornecker  
his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of Twelve Hundred and Fifty (\$250) DOLLARS,

do hereby grant,  
bargain, sell and convey unto said F. W. Buel and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following  
lands lying in the city of Tulsa Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

Lot 3 Block 4 in Fossil's  
Gillette's addition to the city of Tulsa I. T.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same unto the said F. W. Buel and unto his heirs  
and assigns forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said F. W. Buel that they will forever warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Belle Hornecker, wife of the said Henry Hornecker for and in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said F. W. Buel all right of dower and homestead in and to said lands.
