OFFICIAL FORMWARRANTY DEED
WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS.

That we F. F. Bowlin and Addie Bowlin
his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of Seven Hundred DOLLARS,
in hand paid by T. L. Neves
the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged do hereby grant,
bargain, sell and convey unto said T. L. Neves and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following
lands lying in the City of Tulsa Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:
Part of Lot four (4) in block one hundred
and twenty four (24), described as a plat of
land fifty by One Hundred and forty feet
having a frontage of fifty feet on Third Avenue
and depth of One Hundred and forty feet to an
alley between T. L. Neves and Tulsa
of Tulsa to have and to hold the same unto the said T. L. Neves and unto his heirs
and assigns forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said T. L. Neves that we will forever warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Addie Bowlin, wife of the said F. F. Bowlin for and in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said T. L. Neves all right of dower and homestead in and to said lands.
