WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS.

That we John F. Rogers and Mary A. Rogers
his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of Nine Hundred DOLLARS,
to them in hand paid by Lorenzo D. Marr

do hereby grant,
bargain, sell and convey unto said Lorenzo D. Marr and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following
lands lying in the city of Tulsa Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

All of Lot number One in Block
number 198 one hundred ninety eight, according
to the official survey of said city

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same unto the said Lorenzo D. Marr and unto his heirs
and assigns forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said Lorenzo D. Marr that they will forever warrant and de-
fend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Mary A. Rogers, wife of the said John F. Rogers for and in consideration of the said sum of
money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said Lorenzo D. Marr all right of dower and homestead in and to said lands.
