# WARRANTY DEED WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS.

That we H. A. Carns and Myrtle A. Carns  
his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of Five Hundred and no/100 DOLLARS,  
the receipt hereof is hereby acknowledged

do hereby grant,  
bargain, sell and convey unto said Golden S. Fagg and unto her heirs and assigns forever, the following  
lands lying in the brick Nation Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

all of Lot (5) Five in Block one (1) in Carns addition to Tulsa  
Indian Territory according to the filed plat thereof.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same unto the said Golden S. Fagg and unto her heirs  
and assigns forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said Golden S. Fagg that we will forever warrant and de-  
fend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Myrtle A. Carns, wife of the said H. A. Carns for and in consideration of the said sum of  
money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said Golden S. Fagg all right of dower and homestead in and to said lands.
