**WARRANTY DEED
WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.**

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS.

That we Jessie L. Hollis and S. M. Hollis
her husband, for and in consideration of the sum of Five Hundred and seventy-five DOLLARS,
in hand paid by E. B. Griggs the receipt of which is
hereby acknowledged, do hereby grant,
bargain, sell and convey unto said E. B. Griggs and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following

lands lying in the City of Tulsa Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

The west twenty-five (25) feet of lot seven (7) and the
east twenty (20) feet of lot eight in Block three (3)
in Lindsey Addition to City of Tulsa Indian Territory
according to survey and plat thereof

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same unto the said E. B. Griggs and unto his heirs
and assigns forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said E. B. Griggs that they will forever warrant and de-
fend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, S. M. Hollis husband, wife of the said Jessie L. Hollis for and in consideration of the said sum of
money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said E. B. Griggs all right of dower and homestead in and to said lands.
