WARRANTY DEED
WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS.

That we J. A. Friend and Julia A. Friend
his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of Three Hundred and Fifty two (\$352) DOLLARS,
in hand paid by John R. Bradfield the receipt of which is
hereby acknowledged do hereby grant,
bargain, sell and convey unto said John R. Bradfield and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following
lands lying in the Tulsa County State of Oklahoma Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:
an undivided one fifth (1/5) interest in the north west quarter
of the north east quarter of the south west quarter and Lot 137 three of
Section 72 seven township 20, twenty north range 12, thirteen east
of the Indian base and meridian in Cherokee Nation Indian
Territory according to U.S. Survey

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same unto the said John R. Bradfield and unto his heirs
and assigns forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant S. with said John R. Bradfield that they will forever warrant and de-
fend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Julia A. Friend, wife of the said J. A. Friend for and in consideration of the said sum of
money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said John R. Bradfield all right of dower and homestead in and to said lands.
